FEES: **Postal Clubs:** **\$40.00 per club** for the entire season
Postal Individual: **\$20.00** for the entire season
Forks Rifle Club shooters: **Adults: \$35.00 & Juniors: NO FEE** for the entire season
Adult Competitors shooting at the Forks Range will be provided spotters, pastors, targets, and access to the club target house.

ENTRIES: Entries are to be made by submitting the correct fees with your first score. Be sure to indicate each shooters correct NRA classification or indicate if the shooter is a junior.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle and CMP M-1 Rules as updated will be used.

TARGETS & RANGE: The SR at 200 yards or the NRA SR-1 at 100 yards

SCHEDULE: The date given is the last day of the week when each score can be fired. The Forks Club shoots Wednesday each week and it is suggested that your club fire as a group on a specified day to provide weekly match type practice.

COURSE OF FIRE: Commencing at 6:30PM each week on Wednesday at the Forks Range
Stage 1: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record **Slow Fire Standing** at 200 yards. 22 minutes total time limit. Rule 5.12
Stage 2: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record **Rapid Fire Sitting or kneeling** at 200 yards. Fired in two ten shot strings, 60 second time limit each. Rule 5.8 or 5.9

M-1 COURSE OF FIRE:

Stage 1 & 2: 5 sighting shots, 10 shots SF Prone, and 10 shots SF Standing (fired with Stage 1 above)
Stage 3: 10 shots RF Prone from Standing, 70 second time limit) (fired with the first string of Stage 2 above)

AWARDS

An aggregate of the high five (5) scores in an aggregate of stages 1 and 2 will be used for ranking competitors by NRA Classification in the final bulletin. Awards in the form of NRA Award Points will provided for the overall winner in each class at the rate of one award for each five competitors in a class. If there are less than 5 entries in a class, it will be combined with next higher class until there are 5 entries in a class. Additional awards will also be provided to NEW, Unclassified shooters. Unclassified who shot last year, will be classified using their last years scores.

A medal will be provided to high Junior regardless of the number of juniors that enter. An additional junior medals will be provided for each five additional juniors that complete five matches.
