**WINNEQUAH 100 SHOT REGIONAL MATCH – NRA REGISTERED**

**Silver Mountain Electronic Target System will be used. See Range Officer for checking zero at 8:00 am.**

**DATE:** Sat. May 26, 2018, 50 shot 4-Man Team Match (firing time: 8:30 am)(entries close at 7:30 am)  
Sun. May 27, 2018, 100 shot Individual Match (firing time: 8:30 am)(entries close at 7:30 am)

**LOCATION:** Winnequah Gun Club is approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 West to Exit 115; turn right onto County Road CS (0.2 mile); turn left at County Road J (1.1 mile); turn right at County Road J at the T in the road (3.3 miles). Look for Winnequah Gun Club sign and Indoor Range on your left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. The club address is: W10219 Larson Dr., Lodi WI 53555. More information is on the club web site. Camping is permitted; the gate will be open by mid-afternoon on Friday, May 25.

**RULES:** Current NRA High Power Rifle rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and **MUST** be used by all competitors.

**SAFETY:** Bolts cannot be closed until the rifle is shouldered and pointed towards the target.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all competitors, membership in the NRA is NOT required. Competitors must be an NRA member to set a NRA National Record. Teams will consist of four firing members, a captain and/or coach. The team captain and/or coach may be firing members of the team. A team captain **MUST** be named (Rule 12.1). Team representation Club-Rule 2.11; Law Enforcement Agency-Rule 2.12; a Regular Service Unit, or a Reserve Unit (including National Guard)-Rule 2.13; State Association-Rule 2.12; or Junior-Rule 2.18.

**EQUIPMENT:**

- NRA Match Rifle-Rule 3.3; center fire rifle with any sights and a magazine capable of holding 5 rounds. If a scope is used, it must be used for all stages in a course of fire (changing of sights is not permitted).
- Service Rifle-Rules 3.1,3.1.1,3.1.2,3.1.3 (includes .223 Rem)
- There will be two divisions – NRA Match Rifle and Service Rifle

**ENTRIES:** Individual entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA National Match Course classification and NRA membership number if you have one. If you are not an NRA member, a number will be assigned to you for classification purposes only. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6-Assigned Classification, or 19.2-Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament. Confirmations will be sent by email/US mail. Individual match entries will be accepted up to capacity of the range (128) until May 25. Entries received after May 25 will be considered late entries and will be charged a late entry fee.

**Team entries** must be made at the Stat Office by the **Team Captain** before 8:00 am on May 26, 2018 limited to 32 teams. **DO NOT MAIL IN TEAM FEES – ENTRY FORM ONLY. TEAM FEES MUST BE PAID BY TEAM CAPTAIN AT THE STAT OFFICE.**

**FEES:** Make check or money order payable to Winnequah Gun Club; NRA souvenir pins will be given to each competitor.

**TARGETS:**

NRA official targets will be used (Section 4, NRA Rules).

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded. Squadding cards for individual matches will be issued from the Stat Office. Competitors must report to the Stat Office before firing each day. **If your NRA National Match Course classification has changed, please show your new card before squadding is issued.** Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6-Assigned Classification, or 19.2-Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament. A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose their right to compete in that event. Squadding for the Team Match will be given at the Stat Office when registration is completed.

**SATURDAY MAY 26 – 4 MAN TEAM MATCH**  
**(50 shots/person, 2 sighters/position) COACHING ALLOWED!**

Silver Mountain Electronic Target System will be used for scoring. Competitors will be required to score/verify. Failure to do score/verifying duties may result in a DQ.

**Match 1: 4-Man Team Match: The National Match Course**

- 10 shots standing, slow fire, 200 yards
- 10 shots sitting or kneeling from standing, rapid fire, 200 yards, 60 seconds
- 10 shots prone from standing, rapid fire, 300 yards, 70 seconds
- 20 shots prone, slow fire, 600 yards

**SUNDAY MAY 27: INDIVIDUAL (100 SHOT REGIONAL COURSE, STARTING AT 200 YARDS)**

Match 2:	2 sighters, 20 shots for record, standing slow fire, 200 yd, Rule 5.12
Match 3:	2 sighters, 20 shots for record, sitting/kneeling, rapid fire, 200 yd, Rule 5.8 or 5.10
Match 4:	2 sighters, 20 shots for record, prone rapid fire, 300 yd, Rule 5.6
Match 5:	2 sighters, 20 shots for record, prone slow fire, 600 yd, Rule 5.6
Match 6:	2 sighters, 20 shots for record, prone slow fire, 600 yd, Rule 5.6
Match 7:	Slow Fire Aggregate: scores fired in Matches 2,5,6
Match 8:	Rapid Fire Aggregate: scores fired in Matches 3 and 4
Match 9:	Regional Championship: scores fired in Matches 2,3,4,5,6

**AWARDS:** To the Winner, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall a medallion will be provided (if entries warrant). To the winning team, 1<sup>st</sup> place team medals to each firing member. Awards are furnished by the NRA. NRA will provide a medal to each class winner with a minimum of five (5) in the class.

**CATEGORIES AND CLASSES:** Separate class and aggregate awards will be given for civilian service rifle and service rifle if there are more than 5 competitors in each category. There will be no separate categories in the Match Rifle Division. Civilian competitors will be eligible under Rule 2.5, 2.6 and 2.7. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place awards will be given only if there are 5, 10, 15 or more competitors in a given match and class. If there are fewer than 5 High Masters entered, they must fire for Open awards only. High Master Class may not be combined with the Master Class. If there are fewer than 5 entries in a class for awards, they will be combined with the same class in another category. If there are still fewer than 5 entries after combining all categories, there will be NO AWARDS in that class, and all competitors in the lower class will be moved back to their respective category in the next higher class, until there are a minimum of 5 competitors in the combined class.

**SPECIAL AWARDS CATEGORIES:** An award will be given to the High Service Rifle, High Grand Senior, High Woman, High Senior (Rule 2.2.1), High Junior (2 or more)(Rule 2.3)(Match 9). A special award will be given if there are three or more teams using a Service Rifle (all team members must use same type of rifle to be eligible)(Match 9).

**REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS (GRAND AGGREGATE)**

WINNER:	NRA Regional Gold Medallion (minimum of 5 shooters)
2 <sup>nd</sup> place:	NRA Regional Silver Medallion (minimum of 10 shooters)
3 <sup>rd</sup> place:	NRA Regional Bronze Medallion (minimum of 15 shooters)
4-Man Team:	1 <sup>st</sup> place NRA Team Medal will be awarded each firing member (minimum of 3 teams)
Class Awards:	NRA Regional Class Medals (minimum of 5 shooters per class)
