



2018 Minnesota Long Range Regional (1000 yard) Rifle Match Gopher Rifle and Revolver Club - NRA Registered Match

Location: Gopher Rifle and Revolver Club (GRRRC) near Harris, MN.

Directions: From I-35: Exit 152 (Harris, MN). Turn west on County Road 10 and go approx. 1/4 mile. Turn north on County Road 61 (gravel road) for approx. 1.2 miles; follow the sharp left turn. Continue on CR 61 for another 100 yards. Entrance to GRRRC is on the right. Once you enter the Club, follow signs to park at the 1000-yard line (Red Shed). **After leaving the pavement, please drive slowly to keep the dust down for people living along the road.**

Date/Time: Regional Match Saturday and Sunday June 2-3, 2018 at 0900. An optional warm-up match will be available Friday, June 1 at 0900. Note: Friday's optional match is not NRA registered or approved and no prizes will be awarded!

Registration: Pre-registration (with payment) is highly recommended. Pre-registrations must be received by Tuesday, May 29. Competitors who pre-register may request priority squadding. Walk-on entries will be accepted between 0730 and 0830. Entries limited to 60 competitors. All competitors must check in by 0830. Please be on time!!!

Rules: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules will govern **Rifle:** Rule 3.2 **Target:** NRA Official Targets will be used (Section 4, NRA Rules).

Eligibility: Open to all competitors, membership in the NRA is NOT required.

Classification: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. NRA classification cards may be checked by the Statistical Officer. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 - Assigned Classification, or 19.2 - Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament.. If four or fewer in a class they will be combined with the next higher class except masters will not combined with high masters.

Need to know: An effort will be made to squad high masters on the same relay. A fee of \$2.00 per challenge will be collected. Results will be posted to the MRRA website [www.mrra.org]; bring SASE if you want a copy mailed to you. Coaching is allowed in individual matches only while sighters are being fired. Competitors will score and pull targets for each other. There will be an aggregate Service Rifle category if there are at least five competitors.

Teams will consist of 2 firing members, a captain and/or coach if desired, and will represent either a club, Rule 2.11, a law enforcement agency, Rule 2.14, a Regular Service Unit, or a Reserve unit (including National Guard) Rule 2.13. The team captain and/or coach may be firing members of the team. Team match will not be fired if less than three teams register.

In the event there are not at least two F-Open and/or F-TR teams, all F-Class teams will fire as F-Open.

Course of fire: Individual matches are fired prone slow fire from 1000 yards with unlimited* sighters & 20 shots for record in a time limit of 30 minutes. Team match consists of two person teams and are fired prone slow fire from 1000 yards with two (2) sighters & 20 shots for record by each team member in a block time limit of 63 minutes.

* GRRRC Range Safety Rules stipulate that competitors must place a shot on their target within the first six (6) shots. Competitors who fail to do so will be disqualified. Ask for help, if needed.

** Palm rests and "Scheutzen" style butt plates are not permitted.

*** As much as possible, like competitors will fire on the same relay (e.g. F-Open on relay 1, "Sling" & F-TR on relay 2)

Entry Fees: Optional warm-up match fee is \$17. Two day Regional fee is \$60.00; One day Regional fee is \$30. Please note: \$9.00 of the Regional entry fee goes to the NRA. Entry fees include dinner and beverage on both Friday and Saturday evening.

Awards:

To the winner, 2nd, and 3rd place overall a medallion (provided entries warrant). To the winning team, 1st place team medals to each firing member (provided entries warrant) . Awards are furnished by the NRA. GRRC will provide other awards.

Class and Category: NRA class medals will be provided according to the schedule below

F-T/R 2nd Place:	NRA Regional Silver Medallion (with a minimum of 10 Shooters)
F-T/R 3rd Place:	NRA Regional Bronze Medallion (with minimum of 15 shooters)
Class Medals:	NRA Regional Class Medals (with minimum of 5 shooters per class)
Team Winner:	For the winning team, a 1st place team medal will be awarded each firing member (with minimum of 5 teams)

NRA Camp Perry Certificate Awards

The National Rifle Association will award each High Power and Long Range Regional sponsor Camp Perry Entry Fee Credit Certificates to supplement the highest placing Marksmen, Sharpshooter, and Expert class medals. Each Credit Certificate is good for 50% off the entry fee for the NRA High Power or Long Range Championships. The Camp Perry entry fee Credit Certificates will be awarded according to the following guidelines: A Credit Certificate will not be given more than one to a class. (Example: If the match winner is an Expert, then no other Expert will receive a Credit Certificate). Classes may be combined in order to achieve the 10 competitor minimums. Supported shooters are not eligible for Credit Certificates. Competitors can win only one Credit Certificate per event (High Power or Long Range) per year. Certificates are non-transferable. These certificates are numbered and a list of the certificates will be given to the NRA Entry Office at Camp Perry to verify upon remittance. A Credit Certificate won at a High Power Regional can be used for entry in the High Power phase at Camp Perry. A Credit Certificate won at a Long Range regional can be used for entry in the Long Range phase. Credit Certificates will be passed down within class if won by an ineligible person. Credit Certificates earned will expire two years after date of issuing the award.

To receive a Certificate, the Match Director will fill out and submit a Camp Perry Certificate Reporting Form to the NRA High Power Rifle Department. Upon the NRA receiving the Reporting Form, a numbered certificate will then be issued by mail directly to the competitor.
